



Why Do I Do This?

Ignorance? No. As a general rule, I know that the US Flag is supposed to fly above all other flags.

Disrespect? No. I am a veteran of a very unpopular war (police action?). I volunteered for service at a time when my peers were fleeing to Canada. I have fought for the Stars and Stripes. I have seen hostile fire. I have served my country honorably. I wish, through my display, to express the greatest respect to my "One nation under God".

Lack of Patriotism? No. I love the United States and I love it's flag.

Rebellion? No. I am not trying to start a movement to get people to fly the Christian (Church) Flag above the Stars and Stripes. I don't expect anyone to accept the reasons for my display. I am not trying to convince anyone I am right. I just want you to know why I do this.

Free Speech? Not Really. Although I have the right, under free speech, to do what I will with the U.S. Flag, I am not seeking an audience for free speech.

For Spiritual Reasons? YES. There are a number of spiritual reasons as outlined below.

1. "God Bless America!" The Bible states: "Blessed is the nation whose God is the LORD ..." Psalm 33:12a. (The Bible recognizes only one God: the God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob -- the God of the Jews). Hoisting the Christian flag above the US Flag is my way of saying "God Bless America".
2. "In God We Trust" .. Our national motto. Hoisting the Christian flag above the US Flag is my way of saying "In God We Trust".
3. "I pledge allegiance ... one nation under God ...". Hoisting the Christian flag above the US Flag is my way of saying the pledge of allegiance.
4. "We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal, that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable Rights, that among these are Life, Liberty and the pursuit of Happiness." Hoisting the Christian flag above the US Flag is my way of saying that my rights are derived from God and NOT

- from the Bill of Rights or the United Nations Charter.
5. "God protect our service personnel who have been placed in harms way". The Christian flag began flying in a superior position to the US Flag during World War II as a prayer to God to bring our troops home safely from the war. Have the Veterans of Foreign wars forgotten that God preserved them and gave them victory? Hoisting the Christian Flag above the US Flag is my way of praying for the protection and victory of our troops.
 6. "Blessed with victory and peace, may the Heaven rescued land praise the Power that hath made and preserved us a nation" (Star Spangled Banner hymn, 2nd verse). Hoisting the Christian Flag above the US Flag is my way of saying that God created and preserved this nation.
 7. "I swear (or affirm) to defend the CONSTITUTION of the United States from all enemies, both foreign and domestic". Several times in my career I have taken this oath of office. I have never renounced this oath. Having honorably defended the CONSTITUTION from foreign enemies, I find that I must now defend the CONSTITUTION from domestic enemies who are trying to remove the very basis of our CONSTITUTION by throwing out God and subjecting us to the whims of the United Nations. Hoisting the Christian Flag above the US Flag is my way of saying that I am continuing the defense of the CONSTITUTION.
 8. "Thou shalt have no other gods ...". The Ten Commandments and the Bible formed the vision of our Founding Fathers. Hoisting the Christian Flag above the US Flag is my way of saying "Thou shalt have no other gods ...".
 9. "Kill all Jews and Crusaders (Christians) where ever you find them" (Koran). We are in a spiritual warfare. The majority of the world's wars have been fought over religious differences. Despite efforts to secularize our current conflicts with Islamic factions, the issues are spiritual in nature between Paganism, Judaism, Christianity, and Islam. Hoisting the Christian Flag above the US Flag is my way of identifying with the Judeo/Christian system of law that forms the basis of US Jurisprudence.
 10. "Separation of Church and State". This term (falsely assumed to be contained in the Constitution, Bill of Rights, or Declaration of Independence) has been forced upon the people of the United States with the intent of molesting our school children, intimidating our work force, and telling our Christians to "keep your religion in your church buildings." Hoisting the Christian Flag above the US Flag is my way of saying "This nation is STILL under God and I am NOT going to hide my faith in some church building."
 11. "Let your light so shine before men ..." Jesus' command orders me to be a visible spectacle to the world. Hoisting the Christian Flag above the US Flag is my way of obeying Christ's commands.
