The first step is to establish how many Gods exist: one!

- Isai. 43:10. Ye are my witnesses, saith the LORD, and my servant whom I have chosen: that ye may know and believe me, and understand that I am he: **before me there was no God formed, neither shall there be after me.**
- Isai. 44:6. Thus saith the LORD the King of Israel, and his redeemer the LORD of hosts; I am the first, and I am the last; and **beside me there is no God.**
- Isai. 44:8. Fear ye not, neither be afraid: have not I told thee from that time, and have declared it? ye are even my witnesses. **Is there a God beside me? yea, there is no God; I know not any.**
- Isai. 45:5. **I am the LORD, and there is none else, there is no God beside me:** I girded thee, though thou hast not known me:
- Isai. 45:14. Thus saith the LORD, The labour of Egypt, and merchandise of Ethiopia and of the Sabeans, men of stature, shall come over unto thee, and they shall be thine: they shall come after thee; in chains they shall come over, and they shall fall down unto thee, they shall make supplication unto thee, saying, Surely **God is in thee; and there is none else, there is no God.**
- Isai. 45:18. For thus saith the LORD that created the heavens; God himself that formed the earth and made it; he hath established it, he created it not in vain, he formed it to be inhabited: **I am the LORD; and there is none else.**
- Isai. 45:21. Tell ye, and bring them near; yea, let them take counsel together: who hath declared this from ancient time? who hath told it from that time? have not I the LORD? and **there is no God else beside me;** a just God and a Saviour; there is none beside me.
- Isai. 45:22. Look unto me, and be ye saved, all the ends of the earth: for **I am God, and there is none else.**
- Isai. 46:9. Remember the former things of old: for **I am God, and there is none else; I am God, and there is none like me,**
- John. 17:3. And this is life eternal, that they might know thee **the only true God,** and Jesus Christ, whom thou hast sent.
- 1Cor. 8:5. For though there be that are called gods, whether in heaven or in earth, (as there be gods many, and lords many,)
- 1Cor. 8:6. But to us **there is but one God,** the Father, of whom are all things, and we in him; and one Lord Jesus Christ, by whom are all things, and we by him.
- Gala. 4:8. Howbeit then, when ye knew not God, ye did service unto them which **by nature are no gods.**
- Gala. 4:9. But now, after that ye have known God, or rather are known of God, how turn ye again to the weak and beggarly elements, whereunto ye desire again to be in bondage?

In the entire universe, there is only ONE GOD. That ONE GOD has identifies Himself as the God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, the God of Israel, the God of the Jews.
